

Personal Equipment Policy

Because of the wide range of hardware and peripheral equipment available and because of differing levels of hardware quality and security threats, no personal equipment will be allowed to be connected to the school network or other school equipment. This includes desktops, laptops, printers, scanners, digital cameras, and all other equipment unless specifically listed below under *Allowed Equipment*.

Personal equipment may be donated to the school for classroom use. The item must first be approved for donation by the technology department. The donated item will become school property and may be used by the school system in any way the technology department deems appropriate.
